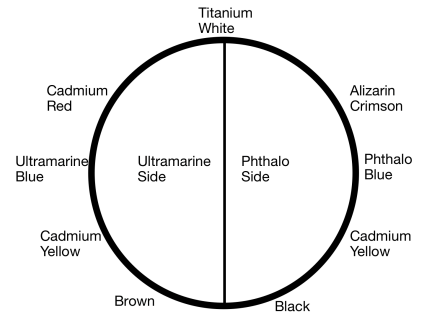




ELIDA'S "FAB FIVE" COLOR MIXING CHART



ACRYLIC COLORS NEEDED

Alizarin Crimson	<input type="checkbox"/>	Cadmium Red	<input type="checkbox"/>	Cadmium Yellow	<input type="checkbox"/>
Phthalo Blue	<input type="checkbox"/>	Ultramarine Blue	<input type="checkbox"/>	Titanium White	<input type="checkbox"/>

MIX THESE COLORS TO MAKE ALL OTHER COLORS:

1. Cadmium Yellow + Phthalo Blue = Grass Green
2. Cadmium Yellow + Phthalo Blue + Titanium White = Turquoise
3. Cadmium Yellow + Ultramarine Blue = Olive Green
4. Cadmium Yellow + Cadmium Red = Orange
5. Alizarin Crimson + Ultramarine Blue = Purple
6. Cadmium Red + Ultramarine Blue + Cadmium Yellow = Brown
7. Alizarin Crimson + Phthalo Blue + Cadmium Yellow = Black

HINTS AND NOTES

- Mixing black is tricky. It is 2 parts Alizarin Crimson, 1 part Phthalo Blue, and 1/2 part Cadmium Yellow. It is best to mix it in that order.
- If you mix brown and black you will get taupe. Just add white a little at a time to lighten it up.
- To warm up your brown, add more yellow and a little red.
- Add white to any color to make it lighter, but make sure you mix the color completely before adding it!
- In the studio, we use Utrecht Studio Acrylics. In this brand, "Crimson" is their name for "Alizarin Crimson" and "Medium Red" is their name for "Cadmium Red".
